## **Chimineas and Outdoor Fireplaces**

The Sturbridge Fire Department allows the use of chimineas and of outdoor fireplaces provided the following instructions are followed:

- You must obtain a campfire/small cooking permit from the Fire Department before you plan on having fire.
- The fire and/or smoke must not pose a hazard to any property(s).
- The smoke must not create a nuisance or health hazard in the neighborhood.
- Any screens or safety devices provided by the manufacturer must be in place. Any homemade appliances constructed, must meet or exceed that safety features that a manufactured one would have.
- A hose or fire extinguisher capable of extinguishing the fire must be with **25 feet** of the chiminea or outdoor fireplace.
- Only ordinary firewood may be burned in the chiminea or outside fireplace. No preservative treated wood, plywood, leaves, hazardous waste or chemicals may be burned at any time.
- The chiminea or outdoor fireplace must be on a non-combustible surface and must not be under any type of overhang, roof or canopy. It must be at least **25 feet** away from any combustible wall or other structure(s).
- Common sense must be used (i.e., a competent adult must be in attendance AT ALL TIMES. A hot chiminea should always be considered a hazard to small children.

If the Fire Department is called to your house for any type of outside fire, we reserve the right to order any fire to be extinguished at the officer's discretion.
