Library Director's Report

Building issues Low Bid \$1.17 Million; Robins will look for ARPA \$ 90,000

- HVAC bid hopefully will be awarded at the May 15 Selectboard meeting
 - 1.2 Million budgeted
 - Need about \$90,000. APRA funds will cover the remaining balance
- We have termites in the front of the building we will be starting a plan with the pest control company
 - Will be covered with Building Maintenance funds
- Trees will be planted in the front of the library where the other ones had been removed because of the leaking pipe. In addition, mulch will be put down soon. Sandra makes a motion to use \$522 from Shumacher fund to landscaping in case it is not covered by the Operating Budget.
 - Senior center added an extra flower bucket
 - Hours fixed on the sign!
- Becky installed new "people counters", this is one of the statistics required on the ARIS
- RFID is not the best fit for our Library
